



Ilex cornuta 'Burfordii Nana'

Dwarf Burford Holly

Plant Type	Evergreen
Size	6-18' high and ½ as wide
Form	Upright and dense
Texture	Medium
Foliage	Alternate, simple, entire, 1 ½-2" long and ½ as wide. Oval to oblong and usually a single spine at the tip of the leaf, lustrous dark green upper and yellow-green beneath, short petiole
Stem	Green
Bark	Gray, smooth
Buds	Small, green
Flowers and Fruit	White, four petals, 1/3' fragrant, March to April. Red berry, not as heavily set as Burford
Exposure	Sun to part shade
Soil	Moist, well-drained, pH 4.5-6.5
Growth Rate	Medium to fast
Hardiness	7-9
Uses	Hedge, foundation, screen
Maintenance	Scale. Plants are heat and drought tolerant. Require moderate fertility. Height easily controlled with pruning. Prune at almost any time, but best after new growth flushes and matures
